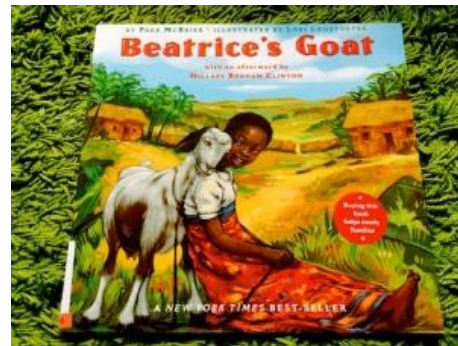
still have some spirit gloves available for those UW games and they will be available to buy at our November meeting.
