EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE - Karen L. Schroeder, Chairperson

The purpose of the X-JWC scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a female student who has financial need. The scholarship was established with Laramie County Community College (LCCC) in 1968 with \$500. For several years the club gave \$500 each year to the LCCC scholarship fund. In 2006, X-JWC endowed their scholarship and contributed \$2,682 which was matched by the State of Wyoming. In 2015, X-JWC budgeted \$1,000 a year for five years for the endowment. This money was matched by the State of Wyoming. X-JWC has paid off this endowment.

There are two X-JWC scholarships:

- One scholarship is a budgeted scholarship and may be used for student educational expenses such as tuition, books, supplies, materials, lab fees, etc. This \$600 scholarship is a line item in the X-JWC approved budget and paid to LCCC by the end of May when funding is available.
- The second scholarship may be used for student educational expenses such as tuition, books, supplies, materials, lab fees, etc. It is funded by the interest earned on the present endowment at LCCC and shall not exceed \$600 a year.

The Scholarship Committee, consisting of Karen Schroeder, Chairperson, Cindy Hardesty, Kathy Petersen, Amy Wagner, Ellen Sevall, and Norine Samuelson, met and selected the following students to receive our scholarships for fall semester 2019:
