

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS.

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ARTICLE 1.

The corporation we propose to organize shall be named and known  
as  
WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS.

ARTICLE 2.

The objects and purposes of the formation are to establish a legal entity to represent the State Federation of Women's Clubs in Wyoming, thereby giving federation power in its corporate name to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, and to accept donations and bequests, and to hold property to carry out the purposes of the Federation, the objects of said Federation being to bring together representatives of various clubs of women in Wyoming, engage in the work of education, economics, culture, philanthropy, civics or charity.

The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and shall have no capital stock, and is organized under the provisions of Chapter 344 of the 1920 Wyoming Compiled Statutes, and all acts amendatory thereof having special reference to the fourth, fifth, sixth and eleventh subdivisions of Section 5396 of said Compiled Statutes, and especially excluding from the objects and purposes of this corporation, those enumerated in subdivisions first, second, third, seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth, twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth and fifteenth.

ARTICLE 3.

In lieu of stockholders the corporation shall be composed of members, and said members shall be all the duly agreed representatives of the various women's clubs in the State of Wyoming, which heretofore,

and now, and hereafter shall be affiliated with the Association heretofore existing and known as the WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS, who shall be in attendance at any annual or called meeting of WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS, and also all persons who shall be in attendance upon said meeting as officers of said Federation.

#### ARTICLE 4.

At any meeting of the Federation, by a vote of a majority of the members present, as shown by the report of the committee on credentials of said meeting, and at the direction of the corporation, these Articles of Incorporation may be amended.

#### ARTICLE 5.

The Constitution and By-laws of the WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS, as now existing, and as they shall be from time to time amended, shall be the By-laws of this corporation, and the affairs of the corporation shall be managed in the same way and manner directed therein, and the officers of the corporation shall be the same as those provided for in the aforesaid Constitution and By-laws, and the officers elected by the Federation in the manner prescribed in its said Constitution and By-laws, shall be the officers and trustees of this corporation, the persons performing the duties of the office of President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer of the said Federation shall be respectively the officers of this corporation, and its Trustees. The number of Trustees of this corporation is <sup>five</sup>~~five~~, and the names of the Trustees who will serve as officers of the corporation during the first year, and until their successors are duly elected and installed, are, Mrs. Guy J. Gay, of Casper, President; Mrs. E. C. Raymond, of Newcastle, Vice-President; <sup>Mrs. A. C. Meloney of Greybull, Vice President</sup> Mrs. W. H. Hamilton, of Evanston, Recording Secretary; Mrs. Oddmund Josenda, of Casper, Corresponding Secretary; and Mrs. R. A. Ferguson, of Wheatland, Treasurer, of WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS.

ARTICLE 6.

The principal place of business of this corporation is the City of Cheyenne, but its business may be transacted at any other place within the State of Wyoming where the WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS may be lawfully assembled, or where the Trustees of this corporation may, pursuant to the By-laws, rules and regulations of the WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS, meet for the transaction of business. Subject to the By-laws, rules and regulations of the WYOMING FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS, in regular convention, adopted, a majority of the Trustees of this corporation is constituted a quorum.

ARTICLE 7.

The term of existence of this corporation is fifty years.

ARTICLE 8.

The private property of the corporate members or officers shall not be liable in any manner for the debts of this corporation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned representatives of the various women's clubs of the State of Wyoming, assembled at and in the annual meeting of the WYOMING STATE FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS in the City of Cheyenne, in said State, and the several officers of said WYOMING STATE FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS, have hereunto, in triplicate, set our hands and seals this 25th day of September, A.D. 1928.
