Here are some of the items we need:

1. Photo in front of the state capitol building. (Cheyenne folks can we get every club member to do this at some time in the next year) To those of you out of Cheyenne, we welcome your visit.
  - A. If you are wearing any type of GFWC shirt, we get additional points.
  - B. We will be posting this to some of our club and states websites to get additional points.
  
2. Photo with elected official (local, state, or federal). Please make sure to identify the elected official by their name and the office they hold. It is okay to have your picture with any elected official that appeared on the official ballot.
  - A. If you are wearing any type of GFWC shirt, we get additional points
  - B. We will be posting this to some of our club and states websites to get additional points.
  
3. Print out the confirmation that you acted upon a Legislation Action Alert. If you receive notice from the national GFWC regarding a Legislation Action Alert and you either agree or disagree, please provide proof that you responded. We don't necessarily need to know whether you agreed or disagreed, just that you responded.

- A. We will be positing the results to our club and state websites to get additional points. Again, we are not reporting whether you agreed or disagreed, just that you responded. We do need to know the nature of the issue, just so we can report which issues was being responded to.
4. If you receive a written response from an elected official let us know. Again, we do not need to know the details of your conversation with the elected official, just that they listened to what you had to say.
5. Copy of all local or state proclamations. We get extra points if it is for Federation Day or Advocates for Children's Week.
6. All photos of members, clubs, or state photo with a member of the Legislation/Public Policy Committee.
  - A. We will be posting these photos to social media.
7. Copy of a "Leave Behind" Sheet identify elected official it was given to.
8. Match a project to a GFWC Resolution. We do need the project identified.
9. Participate in a virtual rally on a bill or issue that GFWC supports/opposes. Please identify the issue, we will be sharing your participation on social media.
10. Testify at a legislative committee hearing or legislative session. Provide a copy of your testimony. If you testify, please let us know which hearing (including date and time), and we will put it from the Legislative Services website.
